He also became quite skilled at fundraising for various non-profit agencies and services. Mr. M retired in 2011.

He was living in those years in Columbia, MD, which is just about exactly half-way between Baltimore and Washington, DC. He discovered a very active gay community in both cities. In those days, DC's premier gay newspaper, The Washington Blade, used to include personal classifieds to help guys meet. Almost as a "lark" Mr. M placed a small AD in 2003 and, low and behold, Bob responded.

They met for coffee. Then had a memorable date the very next day on which they saw the gay play *Lilies*, enjoyed the experience of JR's bar

on 17<sup>th</sup> St., and walked hand-in-hand to the DC Metro. They have been together ever since!

Since Bob was living in Bethesda, MD at the time and Mr. M was still in Columbia, MD, they decided to make their home together in Silver Spring, MD. They bought their condo in Palm Aire in 2012 and retired to South Florida fulltime in 2017.
